Course Description:

Chinese C207 is the continuation of C206. Reading and writing Chinese is still the focus of this course although speaking will be more emphasized than previously. Students are required to be able to read **both** the simplified and traditional Chinese characters and to write **one** of them consistently. By the end of this semester, students will have been introduced to about 1000 characters. And all the students are expected to be able to produce, both in speaking and writing, paragraph-length passages in modern Chinese. With the language skills acquired during the two semesters with the minimum grade B- or above, students should be able to proceed to take the regular third year Chinese.
